Matt Doherty played and coached basketball at the University of North Carolina. He started on the 1982 National Championship team with NBA greats Michael Jordan and James Worthy. The program was led by legendary coach Dean Smith. After one year as the head coach at Notre Dame, Matt took over the UNC program and led them to the 2001 regular season ACC Championship while being named AP National Coach of the Year. Then suddenly, in 2003 he was forced to resign. His leadership style came under severe scrutiny. Matt decided to go on a leadership journey to get better. He studied at the Darden School and The Wharton School along with working with some of the country's top leadership experts.
